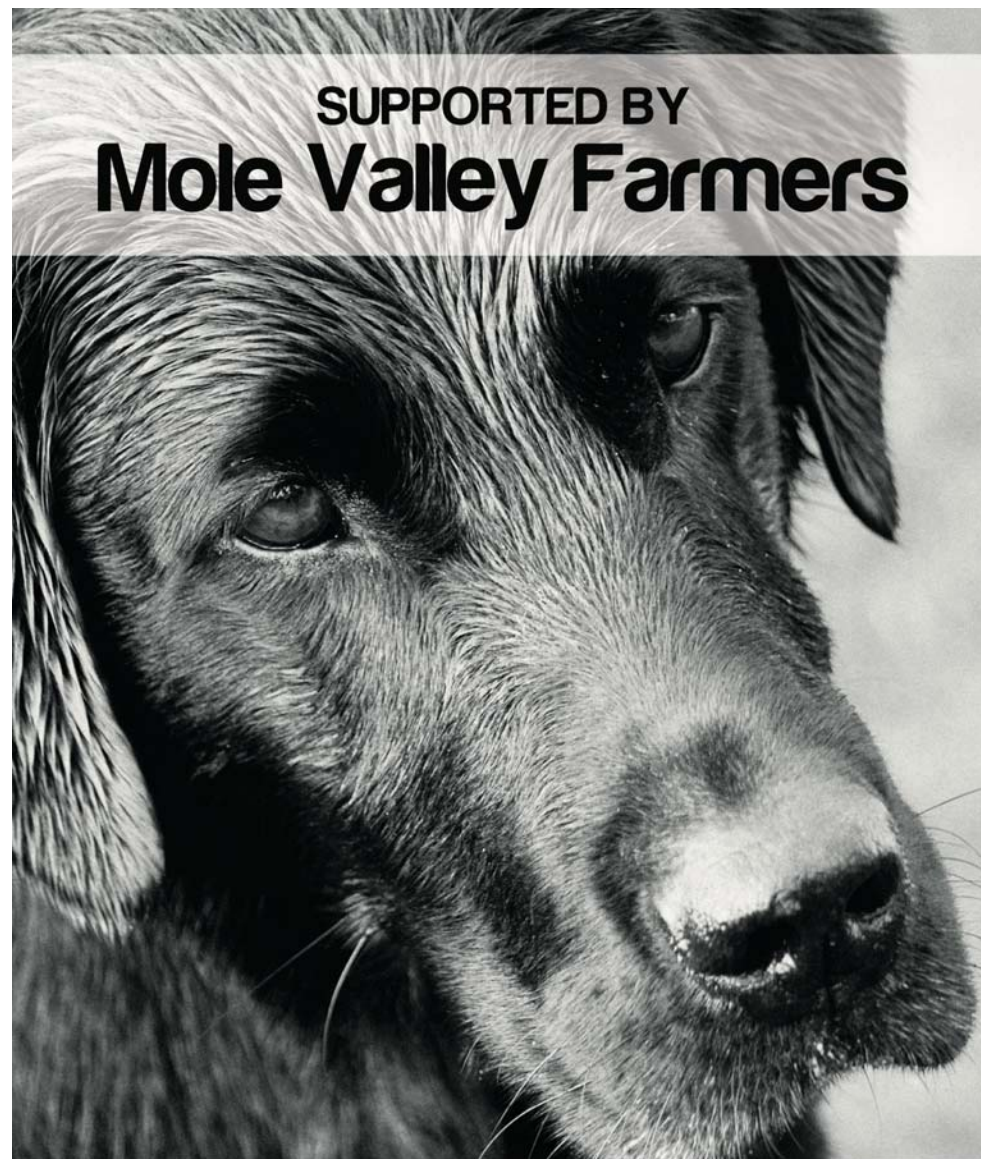

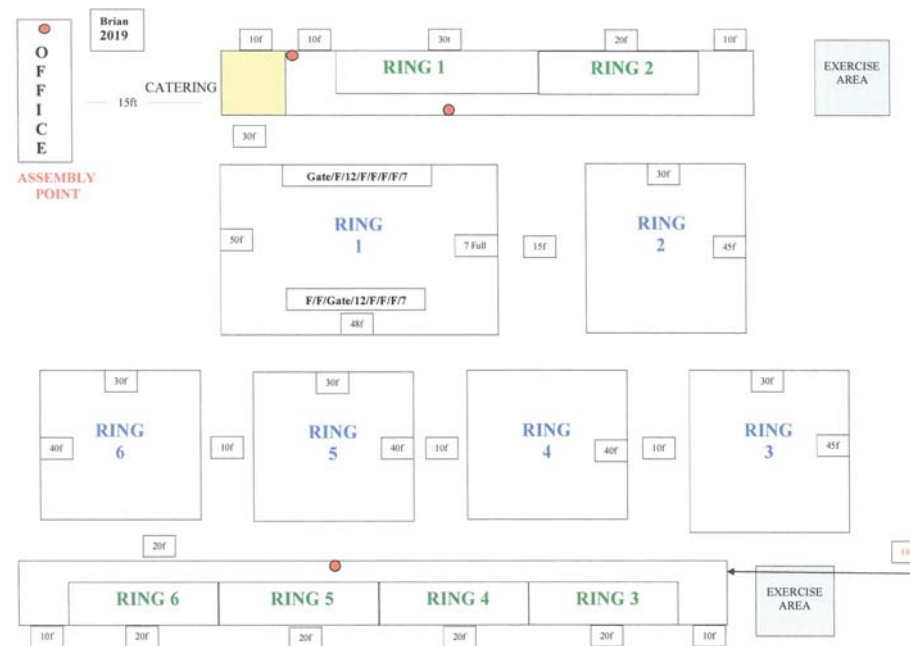

Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition F (B)

- These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these show regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.
 - A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained there at.
 - Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A42.
- No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show.
 - Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part there of may be performed except:
 - Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
 - The removal of dew claws of any breed.
 - Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before the neutered dogs are shown.

Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
- The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objections may however be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at the office before the close of the show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

Welfare of Dogs

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any actions, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Right to Refuse Entries: Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulations to refuse any entry.

PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE DOGS IN VEHICLES

Your dog is vulnerable and **AT RISK** if left in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.

If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to you vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

Car Parking. Please allow yourselves **PLENTY** of time to get to the Showground. Display your car park pass where it can be seen and **not** on top of the dashboard.

Exhibitors Please Note

Eligibility for Competition in Groups and Best Puppy in Group

BOB and Best AVNSC only are allowed to compete for Best in Group.

All puppies unbeaten by another puppy may compete for Best Puppy in Group.

The winners of AV Group Puppy Classes are only eligible to compete for Best Puppy in Group, not for Best in Group unless declared BOB.

Please note that the winner of the Veteran classes is not eligible to compete for Best in Group unless entered and unbeaten in breed classes.

Amendment to Kennel Club Regulations F(1) 12.(6) & F (1) 12 (8) – Address withheld for publication.

Please note the points below:

- 1) Tick the box near your name and address on the front of the entry form if you do **NOT** want your **ADDRESS** to appear in the catalogue. Your name will still be printed above your dog records as normal.
- 2) Your address is still needed for the sending out of schedules and exhibitor passes. So you must still enter your address in the normal way.

Entries without fees or with incorrect fees WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. The Committee have taken the decision that no credit or refund will be given in the respect of incorrect entry fees sent. Bank charges incurred as a result of incorrectly completed or dishonoured cheques will be passed on the exhibitor and any exhibitor failing to pay entry fees and/or bank charges will be reported to the Kennel Club. There will be a surcharge of £10.

Payment for Entry Fees etc. Cheques/PO's should be made payable to "Devon County Agricultural Association". Please do not send cash through the post. Payments can be made by debit or credit card, please complete the card payment section on the back of the entry form. Please enclose a SAE if you require confirmation of receipt of entries/or a VAT receipt. The Organisers reserve the right to return to the exhibitor all entry forms not properly completed in accordance with the directions given in the schedule or under Kennel Club rules. Entries will be accepted on re-submission as long as they satisfy the prementioned requirements.

Eligibility for Competition in Groups and Best Puppy in Group. BOB and Best AVNSC only are allowed to compete for Best in Group.

All puppies unbeaten by another puppy may compete for Best Puppy in Group.

The winners of AV Group Puppy Classes are only eligible to compete for Best Puppy in Group, not for Best in Group unless declared BOB.

Please note that the winners of the Veteran classes are not eligible to compete for Best in Group unless entered and unbeaten in breed classes.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

In accordance with Kennel Club guidelines exhibitors must display exhibit number/owner identification on their crate, cage or container at all times.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1 The Show opens at 8.30 am.
Judging will commence at **9.30 am**.
- 2 Dogs will be received until 12 noon and after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by any special permission of the Show Management.
- 3 Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed, by which time all dogs must be removed.
- 4 Smoking (including e-cigarettes) is **not** permitted in temporary or permanent structures.
Please use the exercise and grooming areas provided. All accidents to be cleared up immediately.
- 5 **Entry Fees:** First entry £7.50 per dog, subsequent entries £3.25 with the same dog. Junior and Adult Handling entries £3.25. Catalogues £3.00 to be ordered and paid for with entries.
- 6 **Prize Money:** The amount of prize money on offer at this Show is - Best in Show £25. Reserve Best in Show £15, Best Puppy in Show £10.
- 7 Right to Refuse Entries. Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that Show Societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulations to refuse any entry.
- 8 Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
- 9 The mating of bitches within the precinct of the show is forbidden.
- 10 **Best Puppy in Show.** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it should automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Where the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed, Best in Group and Best in Show respectively. Best Puppy in Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:
 - a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed.
 - b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day.
 - c) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group or on each day.Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners.
- 11 **Best in Show.** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best of Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register.
 - a. **Shows Judged on the Group System**
(Definition; Shows judged on the Group System includes classes for breeds within more than one group, as defined in Kennel Club Regulation B(A); and require a judge to declare a best of each group after which the exhibits so declared will compete for the award of Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show.)
 - 1) **Best of Breed**
Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.
 - 2) **Best of Group**
Best of group and subsequent placings must be selected from:-
 - a) The Best of Breed winners in each group
 - b) The Best dog from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day.

- c) The Best dog from Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each Group or on each day.
- 3) **Best in Show**
Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection for Best in Show.
- 12 Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
- 13 Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
- 14 All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- 15 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- 16 **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at Kennel Club licensed events.
- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade — take your own shade, for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.
- Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.
- WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK, FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.** Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
- 17 Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
- 18 Not For Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the

- entry form and must be Kennel Club Registered.
- 19 No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- 20 The Dog Show will be held under Kennel Club Rules and Show Regulations.
- 21 All dogs must be registered or transferred at the Kennel Club.
- 22 The Committee reserves the right to change times and order of judging to ensure the smooth running of the Show.
- 23 The Devon County Agricultural Association accepts no responsibility for dogs arriving too late for judging.
- 24 The Association cannot be held responsible for accidents to exhibitors, exhibits or members of the public, not for loss or damage to any article belonging to exhibitors or members of the public.
- 25 Entry forms without correct fees will be ignored.
- 26 The Devon County Agricultural Association can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by standholders at the show and remind exhibitors that grooming products on sale may not meet the requirements of the Regulation for the Preparation of dogs for exhibition F (B).
- 27 **Soft Crates:** The Kennel Club has drawn attention to the potential health and safety implications concerning the use of soft crates at shows as in it's view they do not offer sufficient protection to dogs. Soft crates left unattended at the ringside are a potential hazard particularly when occupied by large breeds, and it has been known for dogs to become distressed and move soft crates along the floor and also escape. Soft crates should only be used when there is sufficient room available and when they can be safely secured.
- 28 Each exhibitor is responsible for providing their own crate or cage identification and should note that the original exhibit/bench number card, as provided by the Show Society, must not be used for this purpose.
- 29 **Force Majeure.** If an event defined hereafter as Force Majeure occurs the DCAA will not be responsible for the financial consequences or any losses or any actions claims or demands caused to or made by an exhibitor or their servants or agents caused by the failure of the Devon County Show to be held on one or more of the days but for the event of Force Majeure on which it would otherwise to be held. Force Majeure means for the purposes of this clause exceptionally inclement weather; flooding of the whole or any part of the Devon County Showground or the whole or any part of the car parks associated with it; an act of God including but not limited to fire, flood, earthquake, windstorm or other natural disaster; act of any sovereign including but not limited to war, invasion, act of foreign enemies, hostilities (whether war be declared or not), civil war, rebellion, revolution, insurrection, military or usurped power or confiscation, nationalisation, requisition, destruction or damage to property by or under the order of any government or public or local authority or imposition of government sanction embargo or similar action; law, judgment, order, decree, embargo, blockade, labour dispute including but not limited to strike, lockout or boycott; interruption or failure of utility service including but not limited to electric power, gas, water or telephone service; failure of the transportation of any personnel equipment, machinery supply or material required by DCAA to run the Devon County Show; breach of contract by any essential personnel; any other matter or cause beyond the control of DCAA.
30. The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of the tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of postal entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. **Wednesday 20th March 2019**. Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value. If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

- (1) *Withdrawal*
The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulation 20.
- (2) *Transfer*
 - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
 - b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or twenty-four calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
 - c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
 - d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

PUPPY for dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR for dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

NOVICE for dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

GRADUATE for dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

POST GRADUATE for dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit or Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

LIMIT for dogs which have not become Show Champions under the Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognized by the Kennel Club or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

OPEN for all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

VETERAN for dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED For breeds of dog for which no separate breed classes are scheduled.

IMPORTED BREED REGISTER For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by the Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class only, with the winning dog being eligible for Best in Group / Best Puppy in Group or Best in Show/Best Puppy in Show as relevant.

NOT FOR COMPETITION Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed. Puppies 6 months and over may be entered NFC. Dogs entered only NFC do not qualify for any entry pass at this Show. These will only be sent out to exhibitors ONLY paying with a main exhibitor's entry fee.

JUNIOR HANDLING A class to be judged on handling, open to all dogs eligible for entry at this Show, the entry being restricted by the age of the handler in each class. Dogs handled must also be entered and exhibited in Breed or AVNSC classes at the same Show.
