GENERAL CHAMPIONSHIP DOG SHOW – SATURDAY 15TH / SUNDAY 16TH DECEMBER 2018
Halls 17, 18, 19, 20 & 6

CHANGE OF JUDGE

As at 18 November 2018 there are no further changes of Judge to the printed schedule. Should any occur they will be advertised on our website, FB page, Higham Press website and notified to the weekly dog paper.

START TIMES

To ensure the majority of our exhibitors are on site before any other event at the NEC, all breeds scheduled first in the ring will commence judging at 9.00am.

GENERAL CAR PARKING

Upon arrival at the NEC site (do NOT head towards the West Car Park) electronic matrix signs will direct you to North Car Parks 2-7; we have arranged for these to be switched on from approx. 6am. SatNav users should input B40 1PP as the postcode. The car park label on your pass is NOT a pre-paid ticket and the NEC will levy a £6 car parking charge payable at booths on the car park prior to leaving.

THESE ARE A GENTLE SLOPE DOWN TO THE HALLS FROM THE CAR PARK AND EXHIBITORS SHOULD BEAR THIS IN MIND WHEN LOADING THEIR TROLLEYS. NEC STAFF WILL BE ON HAND TO OFFER ASSISTANCE IF NEEDED.

ARRANGEMENTS FOR DISABLED EXHIBITORS/VISITORS

Vehicles bearing the official Blue Disabled Badge will be parked inside Hall 16 initially and then on the apron outside Hall 17. From Hall 16 you may either exit to the entrance to Hall 6 along a designated pedestrian route, if your breed is to be judged in Rings 23-40, or the main exhibitor entrances at VE Door 17.4 and 17.3 for Rings 1-22. NB The NEC will levy a £6 car parking charge at the time of parking, please have the correct fee ready to avoid traffic backing up on to the perimeter roads. Concrete blocks form part of the NEC strategic security defences at this entrance. The maximum width for trolleys is 1.2m; exhibitors with trolleys wider than 1.2m will face a slight detour and should bear this in mind when loading their trolleys.

SHUTTLE BUS

A shuttle bus will run from North 4 car park and drop off at Atrium Entrance 2, close to the entrance to Hall 6. It is not anticipated that exhibitors will choose to use this facility due to the proximity of the car parks to the halls but it will transport dogs, trolleys, cages.

In addition a Shuttle Bus will run from the Railway Station and drop off at VE Door 17.3; the bus stop is situated outside Hall 2 and is accessed from the railway bridge link by both a small lift and stairs. NB THE UNDERPASS FROM THE WEST CAR PARK WILL NOT BE OPEN AND EXHIBITORS ARE ADVISED NOT TO WALK AT THE REAR OF THE HALLS AS THIS IS A BUSY INDUSTRIAL ESTATE. Both Shuttle Buses will run from 7am until approximately one hour after the show closes i.e. 7.30pm on Saturday and 9pm on Sunday.

ENTRANCES & CATALOGUES

NB Toy & Terrier exhibitors should enter the halls via VE Door 17.3 ONLY

Access for dogs is via VE Door 17.4, 17.3 and the main entrance into Hall 6. Visitors without dogs may also use these entrances as there are pay booths available but they may prefer to use the Main Visitor Entrance to Hall 20, accessed via the Atrium. Catalogue booths are also sited by both of these entrances; exhibitors entering via Hall 6 should collect their catalogues from the permanent booth situated immediately outside the entrance. These booths will be manned until 11.30am; after that time catalogues may be collected from a central booth sited on the junction of Halls 19 & 20 (opposite the Stakes Ring). **PLEASE HAVE YOUR PASSES READY FOR HANDING OVER BY SEPARATING THEM PRIOR TO ARRIVAL. THIS WILL HELP TO ENSURE A SPEEDY ENTRY IN TO THE HALLS FOR EVERYBODY!**

EXERCISE AREAS

There are designated Exercise Areas in each hall. These are sited adjacent to VE Doors 17.4, 17.3, 19.2, 20.3, 20.1 and Main Entrance to Hall 6. Outdoor Exercise Areas are located at VE Door 17.2 and VE Door 20.1, do not try and take your dogs out via any other VE Door as these are alarmed. Verbal abuse of NEC Security Staff and Show Officials will NOT be tolerated and anyone acting in an inappropriate manner will be asked to leave the show.

PLEASE USE ONLY THE DESIGNATED EXERCISE AREAS AND CLEAR UP AFTER YOUR DOG.

SPECTATOR DOGS

Spectator dogs over 4 months of age will be admitted upon completion of a brief entry form, including a declaration that the dog has not been in contact with a contagious disease in the preceding 3 weeks and an undertaking to keep it under close control at all times, plus payment of the fee of £6 per dog. This facility is available at VE Door 17.4, VE Door 17.3 and Hall 6 Entrance Kiosk.

EYE TESTING

A KC/BVA/ISDS Eye Testing Clinic will be held at the show in the Veterinary Suite (Hall 18). Examination by Mrs Lorna Newman BVMS CertV/Ophthalm MRCVS is available at a cost of £40 per dog (payment in cash please). Gonioscopy is only available by prior arrangement with Mrs Newman. Please remember to bring along your KC Registration Certificate and previous eye certificate.

TRADE STANDS & KC GOOD CITIZEN BRONZE AWARD TESTING

We have our usual array of Trade Stands for all your Christmas shopping needs both canine and human – they are an integral part of the LKA experience so please support them! There is also the opportunity to have your Canine Good Citizen tested at Bronze level at various times during the day. Details will be posted ring side.

BENCH PARTIES

These are again welcomed but please bear in mind the following guidelines: 1) Confine parties to your benching area, our gangways are 3m wide so plenty of room 2) Chairs/tables should not be removed from the rings 3) Please take all rubbish/leftover food home with you especially bottles – DO NOT leave it for others to clear away and 4) Drink sensibly!

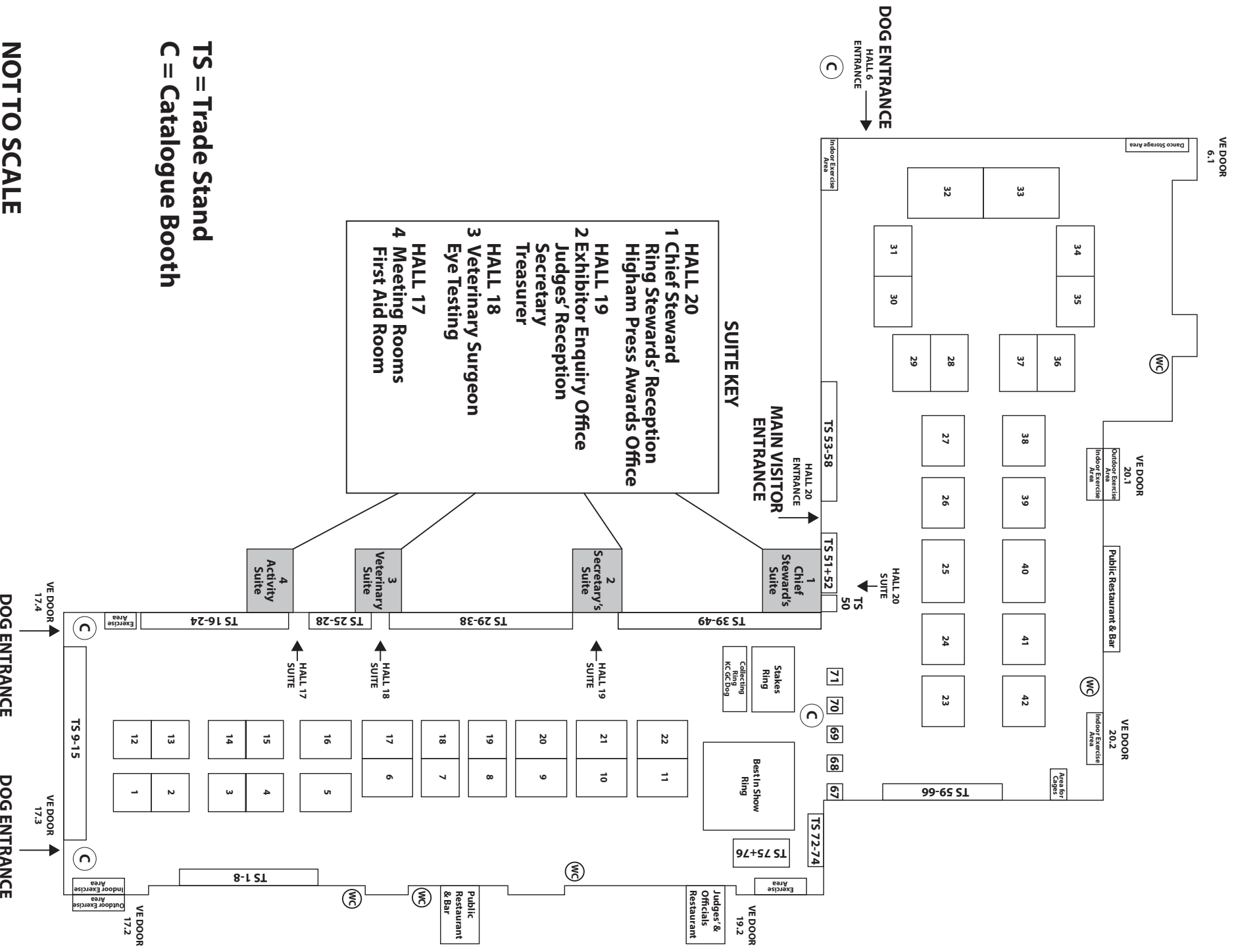
