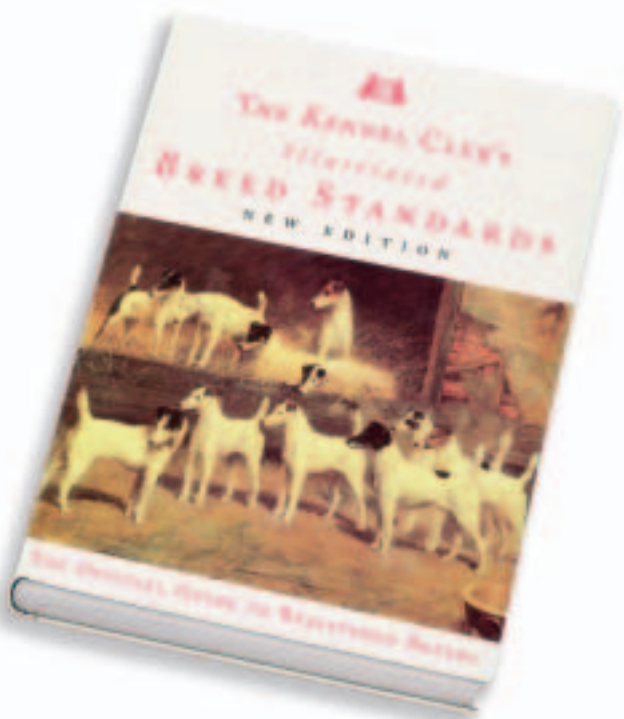

A guide to help you complete the Authority to Compete (ATC) form.

The owner who wishes to apply for an Authority to Compete Number (ATC) should complete this form. It should be completed in **BLOCK CAPITALS** in **black ink** throughout and sent to the Kennel Club.

(1) The Owner(s) name and address

The applicant should be the person who is registered with the relevant Overseas Kennel Club applying for an Authority to Compete Number. Please complete all contact details here.

Declaration

The declaration must be signed by the applicant(s) in order for an Authority to Compete form to be accepted.

(2) Dog Details

Please complete all sections in order for an Authority to Compete Number to be authorised and issued to you.

All applications must be submitted with a 3 Generation Pedigree for the dog, issued by the Kennel Club with which the dog is registered. The ownership on the pedigree should be the same as that of the applicant as stated on this form.

No dogs with cropped ears are eligible to compete at any Kennel Club licensed event.

(3) The Breeder(s) name and address

The Breeder is the person who bred the dog/bitch. Please complete all contact details here.

(4) Fee and Additional Items

There are additional services available with your Authority to Compete application. Please indicate here which items you require including the initial application fee.

Please include the Kennel Name in the space provided to receive the Kennel Gazette subscription for £15.

Dam	<i>Mother of the litter</i>
Sire/Stud Dog	<i>Father of the litter</i>
Whelping	<i>Date puppies born</i>
Breeder	<i>Registered owner of the dam</i>
Progeny	<i>Offspring/puppies</i>
Kennel Name	<i>Name exclusive to breeder</i>

NOTES:

- An ATC number must be obtained before an application can be made for entry to a show in the UK. This number is required on the show entry form.
- Dogs now registered overseas which were originally registered with the Kennel Club, do not require an ATC number since the information needed is already available. Owners of these dogs should declare the original Kennel Club number where the ATC number should be placed on all entry forms. Owners of dogs which have subsequently gained the title of International Champion or a National Champion Title should inform the Kennel Club supplying a copy of the appropriate documentation from the issuing Kennel Club, if they wish to use the title.
- Please note that the Kennel Club only accepts National or International titles. Titles such as Youth Winner, World Champion, Junior Champion etc are not recognised by the Kennel Club. As space is limited, it may not be possible to include all titles.
- On acceptance, the owner of a dog will receive an ATC number, which must be quoted on all entry forms and on all correspondence.
- Prior to exhibition, permission must be sought from the General Committee of the Kennel Club to exhibit any dog that has undergone an operation to alter its natural conformation.
- Dogs which have been spayed or castrated are permitted to be exhibited at Kennel Club licensed events. However, the owner of the dog must inform the Kennel Club, prior to exhibition, of the date of the operation, the name of the veterinary surgeon and the practice where the operation was carried out.
- When travelling to the UK, overseas exhibitors should bear in mind that their dog may be viewed by customs as imported 'goods' and any value that you put on the dog may be subject to import duty. We appreciate that all dogs have an emotional value but the majority of adult dogs do not have a monetary value and your form should reflect this.
