KENNEL CLUB BREEDERS' COMPETITION

Following the Kennel Club's recent press release regarding the new structure for the Kennel Club Breeders' Competition, Three Counties Agricultural Society are pleased to announce that they will schedule the Competition.

Entries can only be made by post, using a Three Counties entry form, and should be sent to Three Counties Agricultural Society, Department D, The Malvern Showground, Malvern, Worcs WR13 6NW.

Entry Fee: £15.00 per team

Each team will consist of a minimum of three and maximum of four dogs of one breed, all bred by the same breeder or breeding partnership. The breeder enters the class and then arranges which dogs are exhibited on the day of the show (only one dog per team needs to be entered in a class at the show, other dogs may enter as Spectator Dogs). Please clearly state the name and affix of the registered breeder(s). Entries will not be taken on the day of the show.
