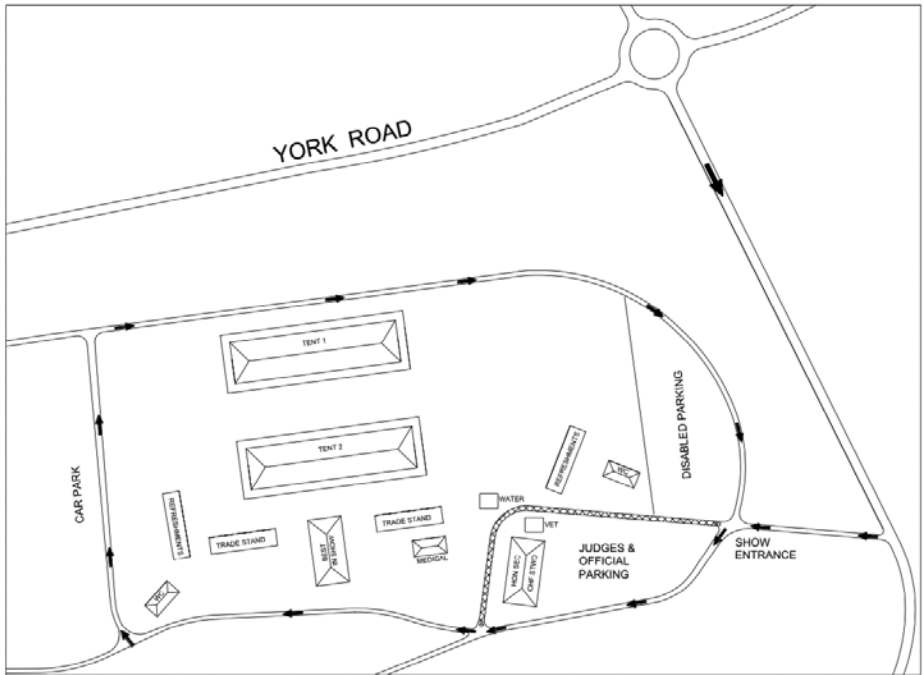

EVENT PLAN



EMERGENCY PLAN

- In the event of an emergency you will be warned by 3 short blasts on an air horn, repeated 4 times at 15 second intervals. This will be followed by a tannoy announcement where possible.
- Proceed at once to the muster areas, these are located either side of the entrance road. Do not stop to collect belongings other than what you absolutely need (phone, purse/wallet, etc). Be aware of your surroundings and look out for any hazard as you proceed.
- Marshalls will be on hand to assist and direct all attendees to the correct areas. Do as instructed and under no circumstances attempt to leave the showground or return to vehicles until instructed safe to do so by the marshalls or emergency services.
- The emergency command post is the Chief Stewards tent.
- Emergency services will be met at the entrance by a marshall and directed where required.
- Emergency vehicles should follow the arrows shown on the above plan or as directed by a marshall.
- In the event of a fire, raise the alarm and move quickly away from the area, do not attempt to fight the fire.
- In the event of a medical emergency proceed to the Medical tent, located to the rear of the Best in Show tent or summon a marshal who will alert the required services.
- If you notice a suspicious package or person(s) do not approach. Alert a marshall to your concerns and move away from the area and await further instruction.
- The all-clear will be notified by one long continuous blast of an air horn

Useful Information for Exhibitors

Planning this show during what has been a challenging period, Driffield Championship Dog Show Society are committed to working with and for our exhibitors and visitors. The issue is the increase in costs and availability of all equipment and services necessary for the staging of the event. Benching will be in place which means that there will be -

NO FACILITIES FOR GAZEBOS: TENTS OR FISHING UMBRELLAS WITHIN THE SHOWGROUND.

In the unlikely event that we must go back to Covid restrictions we will of course comply with all of them.

In the unlikely event that the show must be cancelled, all fees will be refunded less an administration charge of £5 per entry.

The Officers and Committee are looking forward to being able to welcome you to our show where the usual greetings will be given. The aim will be to keep everyone as safe as possible; we ask that those attending please help by following all directions, instructions and requests being made of them.

There will be a "One Way" system of operation for travelling around the Showground, please always follow the signs. Stewards will be on hand to direct vehicles into the car parks, please follow their instructions. Do not park in any areas other than those designated for Exhibitors.

As was the practice before there will be areas set aside for grooming of exhibits, please use them, there will be no obstructions allowed around the rings (no grooming at the ringside).

As is usual all rings will have an element of inside/outside areas. Gangways are specifically a safety device and must not be obstructed at all times, they are not for the use of spectators.

Within each ring a grooming table is provided for the Judge to examine the Exhibit (if required) together with a ramp (if required).

Exhibitors Passes; You will not receive your on-line Exhibitors Pass through the post because they will be delivered to you through your on-line account. You will be informed by an e-mail when your passes are ready, which will be approximately two weeks before the show. The e-mail will include details on how to print your Exhibitors Pass and any other show information. You must print your Exhibitors Pass and take it to the Show. Exhibitors making postal entries will receive their Exhibitors Passes by post in the usual way. If you have not received your e-mail ten days before the start of the show, please contact the printers.

There will be competitions for Best Puppy in Group/Show, Best Veteran in Group/Show and Best Special Beginners in Groups. Those eligible to compete for Best Veteran in Group/Show are dogs/bitches entered in Breed, AVNSC and AV Imported Breed Register classes only, likewise the same applies to Best Puppy

Judging of Breed classes will commence at 9.00am each day. An innovative approach this year will be that AVNSC and Imported Register Breed classes will be judged in Ring 21 which is located in the Best in Show Tent to commence each day at 10am.

Please respect fellow exhibitors, judges, stewards and show officials. Abuse by exhibitors will not be tolerated and any instances may be reported to the Kennel Club.

Exhibitors please note, in accordance with Kennel Club guidelines, Exhibitors must always display exhibit number/ owner on their cage or container.

The Kennel Club Good Citizen Dog Scheme is the largest dog training programme in the UK. Now a well-established dog training programme that has been in operation since 1992. The Scheme is open to all dogs, young or old, pedigree or Crossbreed, whether Kennel Club registered or not.

It provides a quality standard of training for dogs and owners, and incorporates many domestic obedience exercises, with 660,000 certificates of achievement having been awarded to owners and their dogs who have successfully passed the scheme's tests. There are currently around 1,800 dog training clubs and other organisations around the country actively administering the scheme.

Dog owners of any fitness level or disability can take part too. The Scheme is non-competitive and emphasis is placed on the standard of achievement. There are four levels of courses from Puppy Foundation, to Bronze, Silver, and Gold Awards.

Rules and Regulations

- 1 The Show will open at 7.30 am on each day.
- 2 Dogs will be received until 11.00 am and after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management.
- 3 Judging will commence at 9.00 am.
- 4 Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed at which time dogs must be removed.
- 5 Entry Fees (all include VAT): Breeds with CC's: £30.00 1st entry per dog; Breeds without CC's: £16.00 1st entry per dog; Each subsequent entry with same dog: £5.00; Not for Competition: £10.00; Stakes & YKC: £16.00 if 1st entry, £5.00 if subsequent entry. KC Breeders Competition: £15.00 Catalogues: £6.00 prepaid (to be collected by 11.00 am). Caravan: £60.00 if pre-booked: £65.00 if paid on arrival. One night only: £20. You may enter online at www.highampress.co.uk.
- 6 There will be no Prize Money in the Breed or A.V.N.S.C. classes. See adverts for Stakes classes.
- 7 The committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 8 Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
- 9 The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
- 10 **Best Puppy in Show**

Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it may, at the discretion of the judge, be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it may, at the discretion of the judge, be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.

A Shows Judged on the Group System (Definition; Shows judged on Group System - Refer to Regulation F(1)27.b)

 - (1) **Best Puppy in Breed**

A Best Puppy may be declared in each breed from puppies entered in the breed classes.
A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Not Separately classified class(es).
A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register class(es).
 - (2) **Best Puppy in Group**

Best puppy in group and subsequent puppy group placings must be selected from:-
a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed
b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group
c) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group
 - (3) **Best Puppy in Show**

Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in group winners.
- 11 **Best in Show**

The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best of Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register.

 - (a) **Shows Judged on the Group System**
 - (1) **Best of Breed**

Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.
NOTE: The Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/ Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register award relevant to a Category 3 Breed will not be confirmed until the dog has passed an examination by the General and Group Championship Show Veterinary Surgeon.
 - (2) **Best of Group**

Best of Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:-
(a) The Best of Breed winners in each group
(b) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each Group.
(c) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Imported Breed Register class or classes in each Group.
NOTE: The dog declared Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/ Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register from a breed designated by the Kennel Club as a Category 3 Breed is not eligible to compete in the Group competition unless it has passed an examination by the Show's Veterinary Surgeon. If the dog fails to pass the examination it is ineligible to compete in the relevant Group.
 - (3) **Best in Show**

Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.
- 12 Exhibits will not be admitted to Group or Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
- 13 Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such

- practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
- 14 All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B): Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
 - 15 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
 - 16 **Dogs in Vehicles on Hot Days:** Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of the Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
 - When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade — take your own shade, for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.
WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK, FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.
Right to Refuse Entries. Exhibitors/ Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulations to refuse any entry.
 - 17 Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of the Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
 - 18 Not For Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
 - 19 No modifications will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by notification on-line if possible.
 - 20 **Best Veteran in Show** is a Veteran which has competed and is unbeaten by any other Veteran exhibited at the same show.
 - Best Veteran in Breed will be selected from all unbeaten veterans from any breed classes provided they are not beaten by any other veteran.
 - Best Veteran In Group will be selected from all Best Veteran in Breed provided they are unbeaten by any other veteran.
 - Best Veteran In Show will be selected from Best Veteran in Group Winners provided they are unbeaten by any other veteran.

Proviso For the purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
 NB: Veterans entered in the Rob Farnsworth Veteran Stakes ONLY are not eligible to compete for Best Veteran in show. To be eligible to compete for Best Veteran in Show, a veteran must be entered and exhibited in a breed class and win Best Veteran in Breed and Best Veteran in Group.
 - 21 All entries must be made on or before **Wednesday 13th July 2022** upon the forms enclosed for that purpose. They will be accepted provided they bear a Royal Mail postmark not later than the 13th July 2022. In your own interest please use first class mail.
 - 22 Entry fees will not be refunded once an entry is made. The entrance fee of a dog entered but not sent for exhibition will also be forfeited.
 - 23 If acknowledgement of entries is required, a stamped, self-addressed postcard with "receipt" written on the reverse side, should be enclosed for the Secretary's signature.
 - 24 All dogs must be accompanied and have a strong chain and collar.
 - 25 No cages will be provided for Toy dogs.
 - 26 The Committee is empowered to exclude or remove any dog, which is, in the opinion of the Veterinary Surgeon of the Show, not in a fit state for exhibition owing to disease, vice or other cause.
 - 27 The Catalogue will contain the owners' names in each breed in alphabetical order, with their dogs in numerical order. All breeds will be benched together. No bench numbers shall be changed from one pen to another and no dogs shall be benched on any but its own numbered bench. Under no circumstances may partitions between dogs be removed (vide K.C. Reg 17(c)). Exhibits must be removed from their benches half an hour after all judging has been completed.
 - 28 Each exhibitor will receive a Free Pass for each dog entered.
 - 29 No animal other than a dog duly entered for the Show will be allowed within the precincts of the Show during its continuance. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
 - 30 Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his engagement, the Committee reserve to themselves the right of appointing another in their place. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition but no entry fees will be refunded. The Judges will be instructed and empowered to withhold the prize or prizes in any class if, in their opinion, the dog or dogs exhibited do not possess sufficient merit. Judges are not empowered to give prizes beyond

- those offered in the Schedule of Prizes. All Judges are required to take the Classes in each Breed in the order in which they are entered in the Judging Book.
- 31 Conversation is not allowed in the Judging Ring. Exhibitors showing dogs are not permitted to hold conversation with Judges during the competition and any exhibitors who persist in addressing the Judges after being requested not to do so by the Ring Steward, the Judge, or any of the Committee, may be disqualified and any prize awarded to his or her dog or dogs forfeited. No persons other than the exhibitors (officials excepted) will be allowed in the ring during the judging of classes or specials.
 - 32 All Rules & Regulations, or Definitions or Instructions of the nature of Rules and Regulations printed for convenience in other parts of this Schedule shall be deemed to be the Regulations of the Show Committee and shall have the same effect as if they formed part these Regulations.
 - 33 The Committee can accept no responsibility for grooming products advertised or sold by Trade Stand holders at the Show and remind exhibitors that grooming products on sale may not meet requirements of the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
 - 34 Any owner, competitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s) at any Kennel Club licensed show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches. The Show will provide adequate exercise areas for exhibitors to exercise their dogs in. Exhibitors and handlers are required to clear up any fouling by dogs in their charge. Special bins will be provided for the disposal of fouling. Special Stewards will be appointed to enforce the arrangements.
 - 35 Special places will be provided for the convenience of exhibitors desiring to prepare their dogs for exhibition. No exhibitor shall prepare their dog for exhibition anywhere in the Show except these special places.
 - 36 Every exhibitor making an entry or entries for the Show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Kennel Club Limited Rules and Show Regulations and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.
 - 37 **Dogs in Vehicles.** Remedial action will be taken in the event of dogs left in vehicles being found in a distressed condition.
 - 38 The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club licensed events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches.
 - 39 A dog may be disqualified by the General Committee from any award, whether an objection has been lodged or not, if proved amongst other things to have been registered or recorded as having been bred by the scheduled Judge. This shall not apply to a Judge appointed in an emergency.
 - 40 Every exhibitor shall ensure that whilst the dog is being exhibited, its handler shall display the correct ring number.
 - 41 The Committee of the Kennel Club shall be the final court of appeal or umpire in all questions or disputes of any kind whatsoever (except where such powers are delegated by the Kennel Club), arising out of Kennel Club Limited Rules & Regulations. A person attending or entering a dog for any Show shall, by such act, be deemed to have agreed with the Committee of the Kennel Club or delegated authority to refer any such question or dispute to the Committee or delegated authority, as the case may be, under the provisions of the Arbitration Act 1889, or any statutory notice thereof.
 - 42 **Safety of Dogs.** The committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of or damage to any dog, person or property whether arising from accident or any other cause whatever, or from any act or omission of itself, its officers, agents, servants or others or the damage done by the exhibitors to any person or property.
 - 43 **Responsibility.** The committee of the Driffield Championship Dog Show Society will not be in any way responsible for any claim for injury or compensation occasioned by or arising out of the holding of the show or by any reason of the act or default of any person in attendance or present thereat. Neither do they accept any responsibility for loss, damage or theft of any dog tables, cages, boxes or personal effects at this show.
 - 44 **Photography & Video Rights.** The Organisers would like to bring to the attention of exhibitors, trade stands, press and visitors that it is a condition of all those attending the event that no filming or other form of recording may be taken or made at the venue without express written permission of the organisers. The taking of photographs in the show venue for sale or reward is strictly prohibited except with the written permission of the Organisers. Press accredited photographers are provided with permission to take photographs ONLY for use in newspapers, magazines and internet sites – this is for news purposes only. There is no objection to the general public taking photographs of general views of the show, provided that these are for private use. Specific dogs may be photographed only with the approval of the exhibitor. No photography or filming is permitted in breed judging rings whilst judging is actually taking place. However, judges may allow it to happen at the end of classes or after the Challenge Certificate is awarded. Filming and flash photography is allowed from outside the rings at all times unless the operation of the camera is actually affecting exhibits. However, if a powerful flash unit is used or it is clear that exhibits are being affected, a ring steward or the judge is empowered to stop the person concerned.
 - 45 **Attracting of Exhibits.** The attracting of the attention of exhibits by any method from the ringside is prohibited. It is the duty of the Judge, Stewards or Show Executive noticing such attraction to ask that it cease.
 - 46 **Abusive Behaviour.** The society will not tolerate any kind of abusive behaviour to its Officers, Committee or Staff on its showground, Car Park or Caravan Park. Anyone found to be behaving in this manner will be asked to leave and a report sent to the Kennel Club.
 - 47 **Gangways.** Gangways must be kept clear at all times; they are a safety feature not to be treated as observation places.
 - 48 **Abandonment of Show.** In the event of the abandonment of the Show through circumstances beyond the control of the Society, expenses may be defrayed from entry fees to cover the costs of the Show preparation.

Definitions of Classes

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.

Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of postal entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. 6th July 2022.

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. First prizes awarded in any classes defined as Special do not count towards eligibility.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

(1) **WITHDRAWAL**

The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulation F(1)19.

(2) **TRANSFER**

(a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height or, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.

(b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.

(c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.

(d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

Puppy For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

Junior For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

Yearling For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty-four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

Post Graduate For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

Limit For dogs which have not become Show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won 3 or more CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won seven or more First Prizes in all, at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

Open For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

Any Variety not Separately Classified For breeds of dog for which no separate breed classes are scheduled. These classes are not open to breeds which are listed on the Imported Breed Register.

Imported Breed Register For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by The Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class, with the Best Imported Register / Best Imported Register Puppy being eligible for Best in Group / Best Puppy in Group or Best in Show / Best Puppy in Show as relevant. Such breeds may be entered into Imported Breed Register classes and/or Any Variety or Stakes classes, with the exception of AVNSC classes, for which they are not eligible.

Not for Competition Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed.

Special Beginners For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a Challenge Certificate or Reserve Challenge Certificate, or for those breeds not allocated Championship Status, Best of Sex or Reserve Best of Sex at a Championship Show.

Veteran For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

Rob Farnsworth Veteran Stakes Class For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show. Does not qualify for Best Veteran in Group or Best Veteran in Show.

Champion Stakes For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion or Show Champion under Kennel Club Regulation or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.

Puppy Stakes For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

Young Kennel Club Handling Classes Only dogs of six (6) calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for entry into a YKC qualifying stakes class. Dogs must be on the Kennel Club Breed Register to compete in a YKC stakes competition. The first placed member only in each dog group at the qualifying show will qualify for Crufts. A rosette will be awarded. If a member is disqualified, the qualification does not roll down to the next placing. All pedigree dogs are eligible to take part provided the dog is registered on the Kennel Club Breed Register. The dog must be registered a) solely or jointly in the member's name or b) in the name of a close member of the family (i.e. a group of people related by blood or by marriage) and under these circumstances

the dog must be resident at the YKC member's address. No substitute handlers are permitted — the dog must be handled by the registered YKC member. Members are not permitted to allow another individual to show their dog at the qualifier on their behalf if they are not able to attend the class, unless agreed by the YKC Office prior to the show. Members must be aged 6 - 24 years (members 6 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday). Please note that membership of the YKC terminates on a member's 25th birthday. Therefore if a member is aged 25 years or over by the first day of Crufts they will be unable to compete in any YKC class. Please keep this in mind when entering qualifiers throughout the competing year. In order to enter any YKC competition you must be a fully paid up member at the time of entry and competition. If you enter a Crufts qualifier and you have not previously paid your membership fee then any award will be forfeited. Therefore it is important to renew and maintain YKC membership as current if you wish to participate in YKC competitions.

Good Citizen Dog Scheme For dogs that have achieved GCDS Bronze Award certificate or above.

Kennel Club Breeders' Competition—Each team will consist of a minimum of three and maximum of four dogs of one breed, all bred by the same breeder or breeding partnership. The breeder enters the class and then arranges which dogs are exhibited on the day of the show. Please clearly state the name and affix of the registered breeder(s). Entries will not be taken on the day of the show. Teams will be awarded points/prize money in the KC Breeders' Competition as follows: Points 1st; 30; 2nd 15; 3rd 10; 4th 5. Prize Money 1st Non ABS Prize Fund £20; ABS Prize Fund £25. Please note that Assured Breeders will be credited with a higher prize value. These points will be recorded in the Kennel Club Breeders Competition record book through the year. The minimum qualification for the Crufts final will be 50 points, with a maximum of 40 finalists including the winning teams from the European and World Dog Shows' breeders competition. Our Dogs will collate the points and publish a leader board through the year.

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F (B)

- 1 These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club licensed event. Objections may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A11.
 - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
 - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A11.
- 2 (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show.
 - (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- 3 No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:-
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the Board.
 - (b) The removal of dew claws of any breed.
 - (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.Nor must anything be done calculated to be in the opinion of the Board to deceive.
- 4 The Board without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 5 An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 6 Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the show secretary at his/her office before the close of the show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

The attention of exhibitors is drawn to the fact that any advertisement for a coat preparation or shampoo or similar in either Schedule or Catalogue does not imply that the use of such preparation may not contravene Kennel Club Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition F. This also applies to any coat preparation or shampoo or similar on sale at the Show. The attention of exhibitors is directed to the Declaration they are required to sign on the entry form.

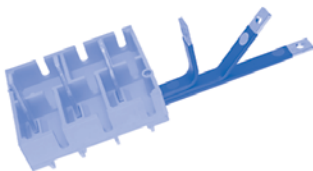
