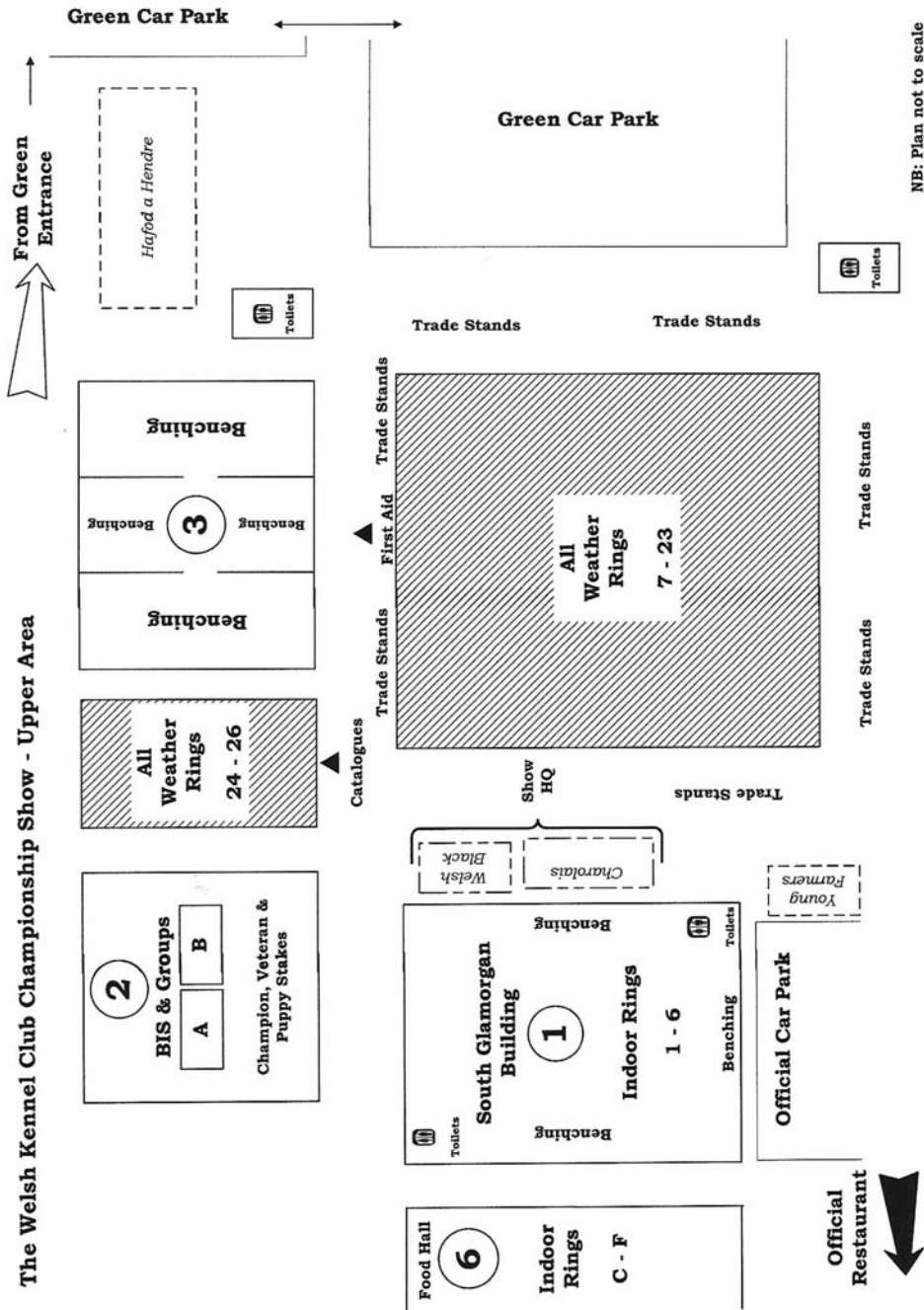

KENNEL CLUB REGULATIONS Extract from Reg F

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:

- (1) Withdrawal
The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations F.(1).19.
- (2) Transfer
 - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
 - b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class to the Open Class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
 - c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open Class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
 - d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

WELFARE OF DOGS

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Limited Rules and Regulations.

Right to Refuse Entries: Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.

RULES & REGULATIONS

**VISCIOUS DOGS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE AND MUST NOT BE BROUGHT TO THE SHOW.
EXHIBITORS ARE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE DONE BY THEIR DOGS DURING THE EXHIBITION.**

1. The show will open at 7.00 a.m. daily.
2. Dogs will be received at any time but it is entirely the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits do not miss their classes regardless of any PROVISIONAL times of judging of individual breeds which might be published beforehand.
3. Judging will commence at 9.30 a.m. unless otherwise notified or published in Our Dogs.
4. The show will close half an hour after judging has been completed by which time dogs must be removed. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club. Exhibits must be removed from their benches by 6 p.m. or when their judging is completed, whichever is later.
5. Details of Entry Fees are on page 14. **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED ONCE AN ENTRY HAS BEEN MADE.** You may enter online at www.highampress.co.uk. **FIRST ENTRY FEES INCREASE BY £2 DURING THE EXTENDED ONLINE PERIOD SATURDAY 9th JULY - FRIDAY 22nd JULY 2022.**
6. Prize money will not be paid except where specifically stated elsewhere in the schedule.
7. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
8. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
9. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
10. **Best Puppy in Show (if scheduled).** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it may, at the discretion of the judge, be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it may, at the discretion of the judge, be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.
 - A. Shows Judged on the group system
(Definition; Shows judged on Group System - Refer to Regulation F(1)27.b)
 - 1) Best Puppy in Breed
A Best Puppy may be declared in each breed from puppies entered in the breed classes.
A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Not Separately classified class(es).
A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register class(es).
 - 2) Best Puppy in Group
Best puppy in group and subsequent puppy group placings must be selected from:-
 - a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed.
 - b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group.
 - c) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group.
 - 3) Best Puppy in Show
Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in group winners.
 - B. Shows Not Judged on the Group System
Best Puppy in Show
Best Puppy in Show and subsequent placings must be selected from those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed, the puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group and the puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group.
- 10b. **Best Veteran in Show** is a Veteran which has competed and is unbeaten by any other Veteran exhibited at the same show.
Best Veteran in Breed will be selected from all unbeaten veterans from any breed classes provided they are not beaten by any other veteran.
Best Veteran in Group will be selected from all Best Veteran in Breed winners.
Best Veteran in Show will be selected from Best Veteran in Group Winners providing they are unbeaten by any other Veteran.
Proviso: For the purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog
11. **Best in Show.** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best of Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register.
 - A. Shows Judged on the Group System
 - 1) Best of Breed
Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.
NOTE: The Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/ Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register award relevant to a Category 3 Breed will not be confirmed until the dog has passed an examination by the General and Group Championship Show Veterinary Surgeon.
 - 2) Best of Group
Best of Group and subsequent group placings must be selected from:-
 - a) The Best of Breed winners in each group.
 - b) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group.
 - c) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Imported Breed Register class or classes in each group.
NOTE: The dog declared Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/ Best Any Variety Imported Breed

Register from a breed designated by The Kennel Club as a Category 3 Breed is not eligible to compete in the Group competition unless it has passed an examination by the Show's Veterinary Surgeon. If the dog fails to pass the examination it is ineligible to compete in the relevant Group.

- 3) Best in Show
Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.
- B. Shows Not Judged on the Group System
Best in Show
Best in Show and subsequent placings must be selected from:
a) Those dogs declared Best of Breed.
b) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group.
c) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Imported Breeds Register class or classes in each group.
12. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
13. Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
14. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
15. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
16. **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.
- WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**
17. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under The Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by The Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
18. Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
19. No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the Board of The Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
20. Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement, the committee reserves the right to appoint a substitute. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition, BUT NO ENTRY FEES CAN BE RETURNED.
21. No animal other than an exhibit, or Spectator Dogs at a cost of £5 per dog, will be allowed within the precincts of the show. Exhibits "Not for Competition" may be entered for a fee of £10, as stated above, and a notice not exceeding 10"x5" with the dog's name printed on it may be displayed over the bench {see F(1) (5) (d)}.
22. The Committee is empowered to exclude or to remove any dog which is not in a fit state for exhibition owing to disease, savage disposition, or any other cause {see Rule F(1) (15)}, and the entry fee will be forfeited.
23. Each exhibit must be brought with a suitable lead and collar so that the exhibit may be properly fastened on the benching.
24. Each exhibit must be benched on the numbered bench allocated to it in the catalogue. Under no circumstances should partitions be removed from benching.
25. Special places will be provided for the cleaning, preparation and exercising of exhibits and no other place on the showground must be used for such purposes.
26. It should be distinctly understood by exhibitors and purchasers of dogs at the show and all other persons that the Committee will not be responsible for the entire or partial loss or detention of or damage to dogs or any other property whether arising from accident or any other cause whatsoever or from any act or omission of themselves or their officers, servants, agents or others. It is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.
27. Gangways must be kept clear at all times. Any obstructions including dog boxes left in gangways will be removed by the Show Management.
28. Fouling. Exhibitors are reminded of Kennel Club Regulations F8 which requires removal as soon as possible of any fouling caused by their dogs at the Show and the environs of the show ground.
29. Acknowledgement of entries. If acknowledgement of entries is required, an addressed, stamped card must be enclosed for the Secretary's signature.

30. Regulations. The Show will be held under Kennel Club Limited Rules and Regulations. All rules and regulations or definitions or instructions in the nature of rules and regulations printed for convenience in other parts of this schedule shall be deemed to form part of these Rules and Regulations.
31. Should any question arise which is not provided for in the Rules and Regulations the decision of the Committee shall be final, subject to appeal to the Kennel Club.
32. All Entries must be made on or before Saturday 9th July 2022 (Postmark), or online by midday on Friday 22nd July 2022.
33. Exhibitors will receive one free pass (not transferable) for each dog entered but in the case of a partnership, an additional pass will be provided.
34. Cancellation or Abandonment: Entry fees will not be refunded in any circumstances where any act of God or any other unforeseen reason causes the cancellation or abandonment of the show after entries have closed.
35. Photography & Video Rights: The Organisers would like to bring the regulation on photography and filming to the attention of exhibitors, trade stands, press or visitors. It is a condition of all those attending the event that no filming or other form of recording may be taken or made at the venue without express written permission of the organisers. The taking of photographs in the show venue for sale or reward is strictly prohibited except with the written permission of the Organisers. Press accredited photographers are provided with permission to take photographs ONLY for use in newspapers, magazines and internet sites - this is for news purposes only. There is no objection to the general public taking photographs of general views of the show, provided that these are for private use. Specific dogs may be photographed only with the approval of the exhibitor. No photography or filming is permitted in breed judging rings whilst judging is actually taking place. However, judges may allow it to happen at the end of classes or after the Challenge Certificate is awarded. Filming and flash photography is allowed from outside the rings at all times unless the operation of the camera is actually affecting exhibits. However, if a powerful flash until is used or it is clear that exhibits are being affected, a ring steward or the judge is empowered to stop the person concerned.

Regulations For The Preparation of Dogs For Exhibition F (Annex B)

1. These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club licensed event. Objections may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A11.
 - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
 - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A11.
2.
 - (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show.
 - (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:-
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the Board.
 - (b) The removal of dew claws of any breed.
 - (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.

Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the Board to deceive.
4. The Board without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the show secretary at his/her office before the close of the show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by The Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of postal entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. Saturday 2nd July 2022. Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. First prizes awarded in any classes defined as Special do not count towards eligibility.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

- (1) Withdrawal

- The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulation F(1)19.
- (2) Transfer
- a. If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height or, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - b. For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - c. For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - d. If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY — For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

PUPPY — For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR — For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

YEARLING — For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty-four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS — For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a Challenge Certificate or Reserve Challenge Certificate, or for those breeds not allocated Championship Status, Best of Sex or Reserve Best of Sex at a Championship Show.

MAIDEN — For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or a First Prize at an Open or Championship show/ (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

NOVICE — For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

DEBUTANT — For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or a First Prize at a Championship Show where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

GRADUATE — For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

POST GRADUATE — For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

LIMIT — For dogs which have not become show Champions under The Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

OPEN — For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

VETERAN — For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

BEST VETERAN — Best Veteran to be selected from the Best Veteran by age for each breed (as Best Puppy).

CHAMPION — For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion or Show Champion under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Kennel Club. **Champion classes may not be scheduled for individual breeds or varieties of breeds.**

RARE BREEDS — Confined to those breeds not granted Challenge Certificates in the current year, with the exception of those breeds whose registration is confined to the Import Breed Register.

IMPORTED BREED REGISTER — For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by The Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class with the Best Imported Register / Best Imported Register Puppy being eligible for Best in Group / Best Puppy in Group or Best in Show / Best Puppy in Show as relevant. Such breeds may be entered into Imported Breed Register classes and/or Any Variety or Stakes classes, with the exception of AVNSC classes, for which they are not eligible.

ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED — For breeds of dog for which no separate breed classes are scheduled. These classes are not open to breeds which are listed on the Imported Breed Register.

ANY VARIETY — A Variety Class is one in which more than one breed or variety of a breed with a breed standard can compete.

YKC MEMBERS' STAKES CRUFTS 2023 QUALIFIER —

- Only dogs of six (6) calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for entry into a YKC qualifying stakes class.
- Dogs must be on The Kennel Club Breed Register to compete in a YKC stakes competition.

- The YKC method for Crufts qualification is a points based system as follows: 1st Place = 30 points / 2nd Place = 15 points / 3rd Place = 10 points
- If a member and dog combination accumulate 30 points or more, they will qualify for the relevant class at the following Crufts. Points will be allocated for the dog and handler pairing. All points are reset to 0 on 1st February each year.
- All pedigree dogs are eligible to take part provided the dog is registered on The Kennel Club Breed Register.
- The dog must be registered; a. solely or jointly in the member's name or b. in the name of a close member of the family (i.e a group of people related by blood or marriage) and under these circumstances the dog must be resident at the YKC member's address.
- No substitute handlers are permitted - the dog must be handled by the registered YKC member. Members are not permitted to allow another individual to show their dog at the qualifier on their behalf if they are not able to attend the class, unless agreed by the YKC Office prior to the show. Members must be aged 6 -24 years (members 6 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday).
- Please note if you enter a Crufts qualifier and you have not previously paid your membership fee then any award will be forfeited. Therefore, it is important to renew and maintain YKC membership as current if you wish to participate in YKC competitions. Before competing, please view a full list of the YKC competition rules at: www.ykc.org.uk and follow the "for members" tab.
- These schedule rules must be read in conjunction with the most up to date YKC Stakes Rules found on the YKC website (www.ykc.org.uk).

YKC HANDLING CLASSES — Only dogs of six (6) calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for entry into a YKC qualifying class. Qualification is on a points basis as follows: 1st place = 30 points; 2nd place = 20 points; 3rd place = 10 points. Members will receive points per group (i.e. if they handle a Bloodhound, they will get points towards the Hound group). If a member gains 30 points in any one group, they will qualify to enter a dog from that group at Crufts 2023. If a member gains 30 or more points in multiple groups, they may only compete with one dog at Crufts, but they will have the option to choose from any of the groups they have 30 or more points in. A full copy of the 2022 rules (for Crufts 2023) can be found here: <https://www.ykc.org.uk/media/9451/ykc-handling-rules-2019-crufts-2022.pdf>. The classes are divided into three age groups: 6-11 years (6 years and up to, but not including 12th birthday), 12-17 years (12 years and up to, but not including 18th birthday), 18-24 years (18 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday). In order to enter any YKC competition, you must be a fully paid up member at the time of entry and competition. If you enter a Crufts qualifier and you have not previously paid your membership fee then any award will be forfeited. Therefore it is important to renew and maintain YKC membership as current if you wish to participate in YKC competitions.

KENNEL CLUB BREEDERS' COMPETITION — Each team will consist of a minimum of three and maximum of four dogs of one breed, all bred by the same breeder or breeding partnership. The breeder enters the class and then arranges which dogs are exhibited on the day of the show (from those dogs duly entered for exhibition in another class at this show). Please clearly state the name and affix of the registered breeder(s). Entries will not be taken on the day of the show. Teams will be awarded points/prize money in the KC Breeders' Competition as follows: Points 1st; 30; 2nd 15; 3rd 10; 4th 5. Prize Money 1st Non ABS Prize Fund £20; ABS Prize Fund £25. Please note that Assured Breeders will be credited with a higher prize value. These points will be recorded in the Kennel Club Breeders Competition record book through the year. The minimum qualification for the Crufts final will be 50 points, with a maximum of 40 finalists including the winning teams from the European and World Dog Shows' breeders competition. Our Dogs will collate the points and publish a leader board through the year.

ANY VARIETY GOOD CITIZEN — For dogs which have achieved their Kennel Club Good Citizen Bronze award certificate or above.

NOT FOR COMPETITION — Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed.

DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.

If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

NOTICE TO CARAVANNERS

The £60 caravan fee covers the period from Wednesday to Monday. The RWAS will make any daily charge of £14 per night for caravans on the ground before or after the stated period. **NO CARAVANS WILL BE ADMITTED BY THE RWAS BEFORE MONDAY 8th AUGUST 2022. THIS DATE IS NOT NEGOTIABLE.**
