

# RICHMOND DOG SHOW SOCIETY

## CAMP SITE RULES (2021)

The camp site is provided by the Society as a facility for those attending the show, subject to the following rules and conditions.

1. It is the Society's policy to ensure that campers, whilst on the site, behave in a civilized and harmonious manner. Failure to observe these rules will result in removal of the offender and access to the facility being refused at future shows.
2. The Warden or Site Manager is employed by and acts on behalf of the Society to ensure the safe, smooth running of the site in accordance with the following regulations.
3. The regulations are deemed to be those of the Kennel Club, Caravan Club, Country Code and local Bye Laws, if not separately covered in the following rules.
4. Pitches must be booked in advance of the show date. This applies to Exhibitors, Judges, Stewards, Officials and those connected with trade stands. Prior to the closing of entries bookings must be made online ([www.dog.biz](http://www.dog.biz)) or by post using the show entry form provided with hard copies of the schedule. Applications may only be sent direct to the Show Secretary after the final closing of entries and are subject to availability. The appropriate fees, as advised in the show schedule must be received with applications otherwise passes will not be issued. Passes must be presented to the Site Warden on arrival before parking on any pitch. Once you have parked on your designated pitch please ensure that your pass remains clearly visible thereafter.
5. No camper will be allowed on site earlier than noon on the Wednesday prior to the first day of the show. Campers must leave the site by noon of the day following the end of the show.
6. The Site Warden, who will mark out the site to ensure a safe and accessible layout, will direct campers to their pitch. Please keep all your equipment within the pitch provided, including towing vehicle, caravan awning, wind breaks, etc. Caravans on adjoining pitches are not to be connected and all caravan hitches are to be positioned as marked.
7. All designated fire and emergency lanes must always be kept clear and unobstructed. The non-emergency phone numbers for the local hospital, police and fire services are respectively 01483 571 122 (**Royal Surrey County Hospital**), 01483 571 212 (**Surrey Police**) and 03456 009 009 (**Surrey (Guildford) Fire and Rescue Service**). In an emergency always call 999. Out of hours (7 PM – 8 AM) emergency veterinary services are available from **Vets Now Guildford** (01483 346 203). Please note that the South Lodge entrance to Loseley Park will be securely closed and unattended between 10pm and 6am and anyone wishing to enter or leave the site outside these hours should do so by arrangement with the warden.
8. No excessive or inconsiderate noise is allowed, including radios, animals and generators. Generators are not to be used between 10pm and 7am.
9. Plastic waste bags are available from the Warden and must be placed in the skips provided when full. No bags or rubbish to be left on site when leaving.
10. Fires should not be lit without the permission of the Warden. Caravans etc. should be equipped with their own current fire extinguisher. Barbeques should only be used with due regard to the safety of others and the use of disposable barbeques is not permitted.
11. **ALL DOGS AND OTHER PETS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AND ON LEADS NOT EXCEEDING 10 FEET WHILST ON SITE. PLEASE DO NOT EXERCISE YOUR DOGS ON ANY OF THE FARMLAND SURROUNDING EITHER THE CAMP SITE OR THE SHOW GROUND. PLEASE OBSERVE ALL RESTRICTIONS AND "NO ACCESS" SIGNS POSTED BY THE LAND OWNER.**
12. Please remember to clear up any excrement deposited by your dogs.
13. For the convenience and safety of your fellow campers please do not exceed the on-site speed limit of 5 mph.
14. Richmond Dog Show Society will not accept liability for any accident, injury, loss or damage to persons or property occupying or using any part of the site, however caused.
15. Any dispute concerning these and all Show regulations will be considered by the Officers and Committee of the Richmond Dog Show Society and their decision will be final and without prejudice.
